Diversified Integrity Resources Quickview HD Assessments are achieved by utilizing a portable HD zoom camera that helps you rapidly understand sewer and stormwater collection system conditions. It allows you to look deep within a pipe from a manhole and/or access point to:

- Diagnose emergency call-outs
- Avoid putting a person into a confined space entry (potentially harmful environment)
- Prioritize CCTV, cleaning, and rehab activities
- View pipes that are too deteriorated for a crawler

Diversified Integrity Resources RV Max 360 HD Assessments are achieved by utilizing the next generation 360° inspection camera engineered for manholes, sewer lines, basins, and other confined spaces. The RV-MAX 360 captures crystal-clear panoramic video with complete 360° coverage, real-time streaming, embedded GPS, along with adjustable lighting modes to ensure no detail is missed. By reducing the need for hazardous confined space entry and minimizing manual labor, DIRs technicians can accelerate condition assessments while maintaining full compliance with NASSCO inspection standards. This inspection helps you rapidly understand sewer and stormwater collection system conditions. It allows you to look down into the manhole to:

- Diagnose potential signs of surging within the asset
- Avoid putting a person into a confined space entry (potentially harmful environment)
- Prioritize Manhole, cleaning, and rehabilitation activities
- Each asset is inspected utilizing a Level 2 Manhole Assessments Certificate Program (MACP) reporting structure.
